

**MINUTES OF THE CALLED MEETING OF PRESBYTERY
OCTOBER 24, 2019
Shallowford Presbyterian Church, Atlanta, GA**

The meeting was opened with prayer by Moderator **Mardee Rightmyer** at 10:02 AM. Before opening the meeting, she expressed gratitude and appreciation for the great turn out.

Donna Wells declared a quorum. (For called meetings of the Presbytery, our quorum requirement is 10% of the minister members...43; 10% of the elder commissioners...43; and 10% of the churches represented...9)

The purpose of the meeting was read to the body: *The purpose of the Called meeting of Presbytery is to act upon a request from the Session of Korean Community Presbyterian Church to assume original jurisdiction for the specific purpose (alone) of handling current judicial cases.*

Executive Presbyter **Aisha Brooks-Lytle** read portions of scripture from the Book of Ephesians and expressed how this gathering was a wonderful illustration of how we as a connectional church, are able to support one another.

The motion was presented, and seconded: That the Presbytery assume original jurisdiction over the session of Korean Community Presbyterian Church for the sole purpose of handling current judicial cases.

After discussion, the moderator called for the vote. The motion was *overwhelmingly approved by a standing vote.*

The body sang, "Blessed Be the Tie That Binds" before the moderator adjourned the meeting with prayer at 10:17 AM.
